## Who We Are

### ICUF Institutions are Accessible

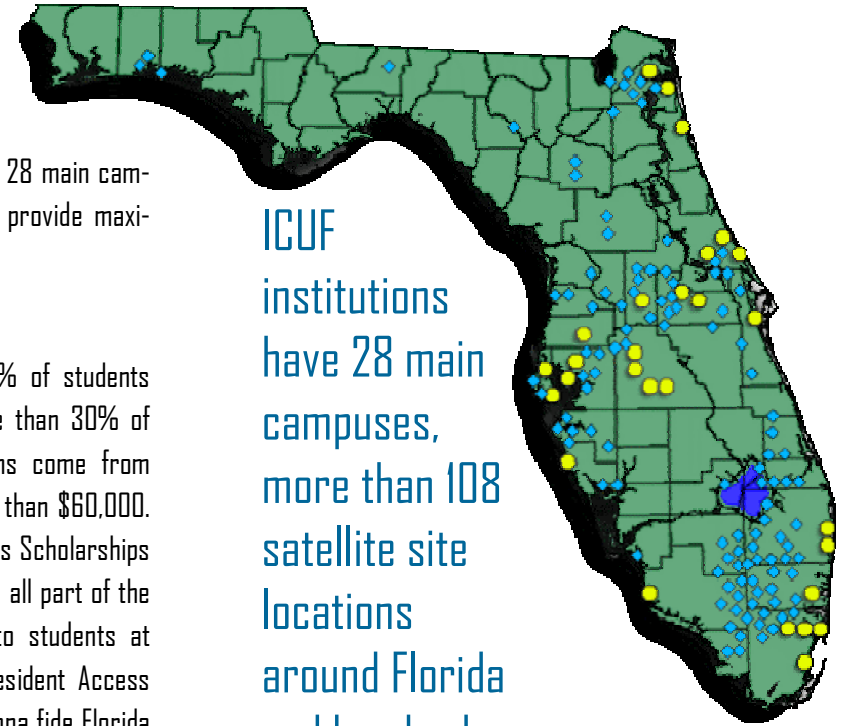
- ICUF institutions have more than 28 main campuses and 108 satellite sites to provide maximum access for Florida students.

### ICUF Institutions are Affordable

- Financial aid is awarded to 80% of students attending ICUF Institutions. More than 30% of the students at ICUF institutions come from families with annual income less than \$60,000. Pell Grants, Florida Bright Futures Scholarships and other merit scholarships are all part of the financial aid options available to students at ICUF institutions. The Florida Resident Access Grant (FRAG) is available to all bona fide Florida residents who attend ICUF institutions full time. In fact, well more than 35,000 Florida students receive the FRAG each year.

### ICUF Institutions are Student-Focused

- At ICUF institutions 87% of the classes have fewer than 30 students. ICUF awards nearly one-third of all degrees earned in Florida each year. More than 2,000 scholarships are offered in music, voice, dance, theatre, art and writing. Extensive programs are offered in both men’s and women’s sports. Social organizations and volunteer opportunities abound.

### ICUF Institutions Offer Great Diversity

- ICUF institutions offer great diversity in student population, size, programs, and campus locations. There are campuses with more than 26,000 students and campuses with less than 150. There are three historically black institutions.
